Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,071
Single restaurant server	\$30,126 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$651
Teacher and office clerk family	\$75,207 and \$43,897 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,780
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,664 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,035
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,823 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,355
Electrician family	One earner at \$69,581 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,209
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,035 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,139
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,166 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,606
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,052 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,779

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,725 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,469
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,804 and \$30,823 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,988
