Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,071
Single restaurant server	\$32,366 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,086
Teacher and office clerk family	\$79,418 and \$46,158 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,620
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,112 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,903
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,060 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,365
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,857 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,134
Plumber family	One earner at \$70,112 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,224
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,598 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,752
Police officer family	One earner at \$87,307 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,896
