Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,071
Single restaurant server	\$32,341 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,085
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,382 and \$46,061 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,446
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,740 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,890
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,777 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,353
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,804 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,160
Plumber family	One earner at \$70,668 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,239
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,469 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,705
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,590 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,932

Firefighter family	One earner at \$74,813 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,551
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,862 and \$30,777 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,988
