Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,669
Single restaurant server	\$38,780 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,230
Teacher and office clerk family	\$91,380 and \$49,432 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,940
Single nurse with overtime	\$103,040 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,557
Single-parent home health aide	\$41,886 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,985
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,579 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,664
Plumber family	One earner at \$79,765 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,778
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,507 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,334
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,906 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,863

Firefighter family	One earner at \$72,335 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,775
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,189 and \$41,886 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,495

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
