Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,178
Single restaurant server	\$19,351 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$207
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,974 and \$40,014 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,855
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,703 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,968
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,753 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,342
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,592 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,024
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,100 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$1,242
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,874 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,803
Police officer family	One earner at \$63,969 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,039

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$49,187 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,192
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$55,251 and \$30,753 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,687

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
