Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,178
Single restaurant server	\$19,787 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$224
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,842 and \$41,084 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,908
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,183 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,947
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,644 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,380
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,940 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,952
Plumber family	One earner at \$56,851 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,950
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,764 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,884
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,012 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,039

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,130 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,190
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,546 and \$31,644 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,774

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
