Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,178
Single restaurant server	\$19,303 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$205
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,417 and \$36,824 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,862
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,725 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,008
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,158 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,365
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,684 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$1,374
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,248 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,231
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,963 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,257
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,834 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$2,076

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,916 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,263
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$50,739 and \$29,158 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,522
