Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,115
Single restaurant server	\$29,782 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$802
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,303 and \$39,267 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,756
Single nurse with overtime	\$77,710 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,626
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,531 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,415
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,629 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,602
Plumber family	One earner at \$62,276 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,261
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,531 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,939
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,071 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,292

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,348 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,177
