Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,115
Single restaurant server	\$26,263 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$604
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,060 and \$39,045 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,715
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,994 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,862
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,637 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,420
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,228 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,232
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,741 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,218
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,062 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,877
Police officer family	One earner at \$77,115 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,875

Firefighter family	One earner at \$67,460 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,606
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,666 and \$31,637 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,382
