Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,299 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$763
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,810 and \$44,272 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,461
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,527 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,990
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,568 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,913
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,204 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,867
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,922 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,942
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,334 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,645
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,853 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,431

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$69,333 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,293
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,621 and \$27,568 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,190

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
