Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,301 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$764
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,834 and \$44,292 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,462
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,651 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,995
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,588 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,916
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,218 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,867
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,984 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,944
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,345 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,645
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,945 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,434

Firefighter family	One earner at \$69,357 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,294
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,645 and \$27,588 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,191
