Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,135 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$751
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,410 and \$42,722 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,746
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,133 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,863
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,218 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,800
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,319 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,898
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,783 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,966
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,191 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,649
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,006 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,073

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$63,226 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,907
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,662 and \$26,218 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,097

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
