Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$29,617 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$712
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,628 and \$42,489 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,717
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,770 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,661
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,152 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,794
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,336 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,478
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,305 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,383
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,792 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,651
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,230 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,995

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,019 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,829
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,907 and \$26,152 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,102
