Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,200 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$756
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,491 and \$43,745 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,440
Single nurse with overtime	\$103,349 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,946
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,393 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,900
Electrician family	One earner at \$60,690 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,852
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,140 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,921
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,142 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,648
Police officer family	One earner at \$95,657 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,398

Firefighter family	One earner at \$68,269 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,264
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,072 and \$27,393 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,169
