Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$28,264 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$625
Teacher and office clerk family	\$57,105 and \$38,386 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,393
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,297 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,193
Single-parent home health aide	\$24,791 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,711
Electrician family	One earner at \$50,451 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,260
Plumber family	One earner at \$51,364 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,214
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,630 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,896
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,001 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,989

Firefighter family	One earner at \$81,560 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,005
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,022 and \$24,791 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,872

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
