Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,863 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$801
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,993 and \$40,465 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,643
Single nurse with overtime	\$92,314 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,532
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,497 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,823
Electrician family	One earner at \$55,802 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,404
Plumber family	One earner at \$62,034 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,890
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,031 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,939
Police officer family	One earner at \$75,769 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,843

Firefighter family	One earner at \$66,411 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,202
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,569 and \$26,497 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,935

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
