Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,655 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$789
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,064 and \$39,859 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,628
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,861 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,515
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,176 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,798
Electrician family	One earner at \$55,410 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,387
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,422 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,873
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,826 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,020
Police officer family	One earner at \$76,165 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,854

Firefighter family	One earner at \$65,747 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,057
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,395 and \$26,176 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,921
