Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$30,574 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$784
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,656 and \$41,232 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,655
Single nurse with overtime	\$92,447 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,537
Single-parent home health aide	\$25,755 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,763
Electrician family	One earner at \$60,783 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,855
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,998 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,945
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,541 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,732
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,811 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,012

Firefighter family	One earner at \$56,389 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,609
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,054 and \$25,755 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,984

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
