Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$31,408 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$831
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,215 and \$44,385 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,759
Single nurse with overtime	\$100,595 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,842
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,998 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,316
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,750 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,882
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,383 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,983
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,501 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,663
Police officer family	One earner at \$87,991 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,184

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,929 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,900
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,913 and \$28,998 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,182

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
