Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$24,110 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$421
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,613 and \$32,776 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,446
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,206 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,115
Single-parent home health aide	\$24,580 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,725
Electrician family	One earner at \$47,545 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,051
Plumber family	One earner at \$48,680 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,100
Construction worker family	One earner at \$33,783 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,013
Police officer family	One earner at \$60,968 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,330

Firefighter family	One earner at \$51,332 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,039
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$48,837 and \$24,580 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,778
