Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$31,226 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$821
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,095 and \$43,124 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,720
Single nurse with overtime	\$96,544 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,690
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,490 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,907
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,739 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,826
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,715 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,965
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,126 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,648
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,780 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,039

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$64,574 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,940
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$55,759 and \$27,490 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,052

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
