Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,226
Single restaurant server	\$31,520 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$836
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,194 and \$44,874 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,387
Single nurse with overtime	\$100,581 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,842
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,422 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,321
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,574 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,905
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,008 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,001
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,748 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,697
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,838 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,208

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$63,093 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,904
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$59,246 and \$29,422 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,203

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
