Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,167 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,043
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,585 and \$45,218 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,710
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,026 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,078
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,688 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,605
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,457 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,801
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,096 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,737
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,344 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,840
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,342 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$7,514

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$57,624 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,483
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$64,852 and \$38,688 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$8,035
