Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,091
Single restaurant server	\$32,167 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,043
Teacher and office clerk family	\$72,511 and \$46,399 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,850
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,649 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,094
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,960 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,668
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,416 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,827
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,736 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,836
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,710 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,059
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,281 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$7,539

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,771 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,210
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$65,462 and \$38,960 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$8,059

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
