Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,136
Single restaurant server	\$39,204 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,322
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,222 and \$47,832 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,274
Single nurse with overtime	\$94,137 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,492
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,937 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,354
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,298 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,842
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,125 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,783
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,617 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,432
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,008 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,359

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,790 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,619
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,762 and \$30,937 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,206
