Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,136
Single restaurant server	\$39,119 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,315
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,062 and \$45,002 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,287
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,029 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,196
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,443 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,312
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,429 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,819
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,673 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,825
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,048 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,311
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,564 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,636

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$61,069 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,604
