Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,136
Single restaurant server	\$38,945 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,302
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,208 and \$45,792 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,738
Single nurse with overtime	\$94,658 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,511
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,679 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,317
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,332 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,816
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,221 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,705
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,766 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,413
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,386 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,676

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$59,567 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,571
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$59,103 and \$29,679 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,208

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
