Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,136
Single restaurant server	\$39,890 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,374
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,056 and \$51,654 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,881
Single nurse with overtime	\$97,740 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,624
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,841 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,588
Electrician family	One earner at \$76,096 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,351
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,425 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,819
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,840 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,787
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,752 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,045

Firefighter family	One earner at \$64,560 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,680
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,110 and \$36,841 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,430

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
