Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,136
Single restaurant server	\$40,740 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,438
Teacher and office clerk family	\$81,100 and \$54,328 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,276
Single nurse with overtime	\$107,879 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,995
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,477 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,692
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,959 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,769
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,853 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,127
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,279 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,884
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,399 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,198

Firefighter family	One earner at \$71,892 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,437
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,575 and \$39,477 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,568
