Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,362
Single restaurant server	\$64,556 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$3,268
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,008 and \$49,962 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,202
Single nurse with overtime	\$90,247 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,883
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,311 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,527
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,242 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,032
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,175 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,057
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,495 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,106
Police officer family	One earner at \$67,503 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,349

Firefighter family	One earner at \$48,891 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,488
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,734 and \$36,311 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,132
