Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,293
Single restaurant server	\$38,349 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,243
Teacher and office clerk family	\$88,354 and \$53,172 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$10,053
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,328 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,825
Single-parent home health aide	\$47,020 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,286
Electrician family	One earner at \$107,954 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,722
Plumber family	One earner at \$105,952 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,163
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,344 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,499
Police officer family	One earner at \$102,891 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,278

Firefighter family	One earner at \$90,636 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,938
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$67,262 and \$47,020 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,793
