Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,293
Single restaurant server	\$48,446 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,014
Teacher and office clerk family	\$94,842 and \$49,677 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$10,264
Single nurse with overtime	\$106,146 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,978
Single-parent home health aide	\$47,920 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,278
Electrician family	One earner at \$106,860 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,188
Plumber family	One earner at \$99,087 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,972
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,417 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,501
Police officer family	One earner at \$104,622 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,326

Firefighter family	One earner at \$59,566 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,865
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,705 and \$47,920 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,623
