Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,293
Single restaurant server	\$51,679 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,263
Teacher and office clerk family	\$105,778 and \$56,851 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$12,082
Single nurse with overtime	\$125,668 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,706
Single-parent home health aide	\$49,485 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,313
Electrician family	One earner at \$107,682 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,211
Plumber family	One earner at \$92,377 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,786
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,263 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,980
Police officer family	One earner at \$121,036 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,161

Firefighter family	One earner at \$108,339 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,932
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$73,438 and \$49,485 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,419
