Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,293
Single restaurant server	\$51,663 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,262
Teacher and office clerk family	\$105,686 and \$56,825 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$12,078
Single nurse with overtime	\$125,620 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,704
Single-parent home health aide	\$49,484 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,313
Electrician family	One earner at \$107,685 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,211
Plumber family	One earner at \$92,313 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,785
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,219 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,978
Police officer family	One earner at \$120,977 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,154

Firefighter family	One earner at \$108,188 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,928
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$73,406 and \$49,484 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,416
