Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,099
Single restaurant server	\$32,323 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$891
Teacher and office clerk family	\$69,094 and \$47,902 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,329
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,319 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,281
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,118 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,641
Electrician family	One earner at \$82,262 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,689
Plumber family	One earner at \$105,257 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,279
Construction worker family	One earner at \$56,633 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,525
Police officer family	One earner at \$87,985 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,012

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,631 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,867
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,360 and \$38,118 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,323
