Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,099
Single restaurant server	\$28,004 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$552
Teacher and office clerk family	\$71,443 and \$49,572 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,579
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,165 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,604
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,008 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,637
Electrician family	One earner at \$96,323 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,037
Plumber family	One earner at \$99,085 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,112
Construction worker family	One earner at \$62,284 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,926
Police officer family	One earner at \$93,576 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,163

Firefighter family	One earner at \$46,298 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,413
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,262 and \$38,008 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,398
