Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,099
Single restaurant server	\$31,700 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$860
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,282 and \$45,436 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,129
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,018 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,974
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,901 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,510
Electrician family	One earner at \$81,418 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,666
Plumber family	One earner at \$86,993 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,786
Construction worker family	One earner at \$58,737 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,728
Police officer family	One earner at \$97,157 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,260

Firefighter family	One earner at \$52,156 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,846
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,288 and \$34,901 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,261
