Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,099
Single restaurant server	\$31,605 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$856
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,816 and \$45,750 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,126
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,874 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,005
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,377 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,529
Electrician family	One earner at \$81,397 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,666
Plumber family	One earner at \$89,727 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,859
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,737 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,634
Police officer family	One earner at \$93,356 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,157

Firefighter family	One earner at \$54,529 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,367
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,444 and \$35,377 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,278
