Single restaurant server	\$30,652 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$804
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,238 and \$46,504 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,107
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,897 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,824
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,573 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,578
Electrician family	One earner at \$74,600 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,481
Plumber family	One earner at \$89,070 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,841
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,242 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,621
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,663 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,935
