Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,299
Single restaurant server	\$39,381 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,288
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,318 and \$51,913 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,962
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,563 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,649
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,399 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,680
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,071 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,405
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,108 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,081
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,914 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,071
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,839 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,790

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$69,672 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,376
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$59,922 and \$37,399 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,130

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
