Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,036
Single restaurant server	\$26,857 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$539
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,043 and \$44,737 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,370
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,686 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,858
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,152 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,481
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,847 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,266
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,160 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,938
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,605 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,906
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,082 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,222

Firefighter family	One earner at \$54,954 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,439
