Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,107
Single restaurant server	\$38,929 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,282
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,439 and \$49,061 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,604
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,690 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,584
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,282 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,399
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,040 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,880
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,648 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,952
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,966 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,056
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,121 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,728

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,161 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,827
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$56,904 and \$38,282 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,237
