Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,159
Single restaurant server	\$33,449 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,013
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,527 and \$33,036 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,941
Single nurse with overtime	\$82,733 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,822
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,937 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,260
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,531 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,038
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,580 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,066
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,492 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,855
Police officer family	One earner at \$59,999 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,625

Firefighter family	One earner at \$46,697 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,904
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,348 and \$30,937 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,934
