Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,122
Single restaurant server	\$26,454 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$583
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,554 and \$45,987 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,494
Single nurse with overtime	\$108,095 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,223
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,181 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,366
Electrician family	One earner at \$68,838 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,113
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,719 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,970
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,640 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,601
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,379 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,718

Firefighter family	One earner at \$71,138 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,377
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,546 and \$31,181 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,062
